Vendor Booths

The 18th annual **Blackberry Jam** will be held in Lowell, Oregon on July 27, 28 & 29. We will be holding this annual *free admission* event in the Rolling Rock Park area. For more information about our event feel free to explore www.blackberryjamfestival.com or phone 1-866-516-5534.

Spaces will be available on a first-come, first served basis. The cost for crafters will be \$40.00 (non-refundable) for every 10 x 10 ft. space you occupy and the cost for commercial booths will be \$75.00 for every 10 x 10 ft. space (non-refundable). Roving vendors charge is \$20.00 (non-refundable). Craft booths must have 50% of their wares handmade to qualify. This fee covers all three days of the event. If you pay your fees by **May 1, 2012** you will be listed in the program which is distributed through out the local area. You will need to bring your own tables, tarps, awnings, etc. All trash must be taken to the dumpster daily or more often if necessary. **No pets, alcohol or drugs will be allowed on the festival premises.**

If you need access to either water or electricity (specify 110V or 220V) to operate your booth please note that on your application. Electrical hookups will be an additional \$10. Setup times are from 11:00 until 5:00 on Friday the 27th . Booths must be ready for sales and staffed during the following hours:

July 27	Friday	5:00 PM – 8:00 PM (or until 10:00 if you wish)
July 28	Saturday	10:00 AM – 8:00 PM (or until 10:00 if you wish)
July 29	Sunday	11:00 AM until 4:00 PM, then clean-up your area

Most booths will not be accessible by vehicles, so plan to carry your items into your booth area. Parking will be allowed near your assigned booth area for **loading and unloading only**.

Please mail in Booth Registration Form and pay your fees by **July 1, 2012**. Make your check out to **Blackberry Jam Festival**. Only cash will be accepted after this date. You may drop the completed registration form and payment by Lowell City Hall at 107 East 3rd Street Lowell. Make sure you have it in a sealed envelope and clearly labeled **“Blackberry Jam Vendor”**.
